Logan Square

Logan Square's history included public executions and burial plots until the early 19th century. The Swann Memorial Fountain uses large Native American figures to depict the areas major water sources; the Delaware, Schuylkill and Wissahickon.

Eakins Oval Named for famed Philadelphia artist Thomas Eakins, it is home to the Washington Monument Fountain, created by Rudolf Siemering which features a statue of George Washington atop his horse facing down Benjamin Franklin Parkway toward Philadelphia City Hall.

The Franklin Institute Established in 1824 and named for Founding Father Benjamin Franklin, the museum exhibits include Electricity, The Giant Heart, as well as displays of telescopes, space travel and the world's largest collection of Wright Brothers' artifacts.

The Barnes Foundation The Barnes Foundation holds more than 2,500 objects, primarily from impressionist and modern masters, including Renoir, Rubens, Goya, Manet, Cezanne, Matisse, Picasso, Rousseau, Modigliani, and Seurat, in addition to a 12-acre arboretum with over 3,000 species of plants and trees.

Rodin Museum AB Featuring the world's second largest collection of Auguste Rodin's works, including the statue, The Thinker.

Rocky Steps & the Rocky Statue

The 72 stone steps before the entrance of the Philadelphia Museum of Art have become known as the "Rocky Steps", from the Rocky movies, with a bronze statue of Rocky Balboa.
